REGULATION OF MASTER'S PROGRAMME MOBILITY

"Environmental Communication and Health Promotion"

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The postgraduate students of the "Environmental Communication and Health Promotion" program can participate in the ERASMUS student exchange programs, within the framework of the international agreements of the Department of Health and Human Services with similar institutions and register as guests students.

Participation in the ERASMUS program, by attending courses or preparing the post-graduate diploma thesis at a host University abroad, becomes possible after submitting a relevant request to the SE of the PMS. A necessary condition is the successful completion of the first semester of studies at PMS and knowledge of the language of instruction of the host University. The academic recognition of the period of study abroad is achieved as follows:

Students choose from the host University's curriculum courses which correspond to the PMS courses and cover the credits (ECTS) of the PMS courses (the matching does not have to be one-to-one, e.g. two courses of the department host may correspond to one of the PMS and vice versa). The recognition of the studies is done through the transfer and matching of these credit units with PMS courses, as long as the students have been successfully examined at the host institution.
